Calgary Stampede Rodeo showcases the skill of the cowgirls and cowboys competing, but also the quality of the animals: bulls, horses and oxen. It is a display of true grit. It's only the best of the best, celebrating western culture and delighting spectators from around the world.

For a genuinely unique experience, explore the rich culture and traditions of First Nations peoples in Elbow River Camp. Stunning jewellery and art is displayed in twenty-six colourful round tents called tipis, each with a unique design on the outside. Traditional legends are told and stories shared, allowing the listeners to dive into the fascinating history of First Nations.

A Powwow, a ceremony including dancing in traditional clothes, is held daily and visitors are sometimes encouraged to join in. You don't want to miss bannock bread with Saskatoon berry jam, a local delicacy.
